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

INDIA: A JOURNEY OF **DISCOVERY**

Reflecting on my year-and-a-half journey of travels, connections, and milestones as the Ambassador of the US to India

first came to India as a 14-year-old with my sister and my parents. India captured my heart. Over the decades, I have seen so much change, as a modern and proud country was reborn, but one thing has stayed the same the hospitality and generosity of this incredible place and the people who define and redefine it every day. It is such a privilege to live in India at such an exciting time, as the US-India partnership becomes stronger and more important than ever. I tell all my American friends: if you've never been to India, it's time to come; if you've been before, it's time to return.

In that spirit, every journey I undertake here is not just a diplomatic mission but also a personal exploration of a land that captivates the senses with its rich tapestry of landscapes, cultures, and culinary delights. My travels across India have provided me with a deeper appreciation for the nation's

diversity, its vibrant traditions, and the warmth of its people.

EXPLORING THE COUNTRY

One of the most unforgettable experiences of my tenure in India was my visit to Kanyakumari at the southernmost tip of the Indian subcontinent, Standing at the confluence of the Indian Ocean, the Bay of Bengal, and the Arabian Sea, I was greeted by a breathtaking sunrise that painted the sky in hues of orange, pink, and purple. It was a moment of sheer beauty, a reminder of the natural splendour that India possesses. I am amazed by the contrast between this southern gem, with its tranquil beaches and spiritual significance, against the picturesque mountains and valleys of Nagaland, which I had the honour of visiting last fall. India's geographical diversity is nothing short of mesmerising.

As I've travelled from the vibrant streets of Mumbai to the beating cultural heart of

Kolkata, I've been continually amazed by the distinct flavours, languages, and traditions that define each region. Mumbai's energy is contagious, with its fast-paced lifestyle and ever-evolving skyline, while Kolkata's historic charm, with its colonial architecture and literary heritage, offers a window into India's rich past. Every city, every town I visit adds another layer to my understanding of this incredible country.

SAVOURING DIVERSE FLAVOURS

India's culinary heritage is equally diverse. From spicy chaats to sweet jalebis, the variety is endless, and each dish tells a story of the city's rich history and diverse population. In Chennai,

during our National Day celebrations, the event's menu was carefully curated to reflect the region's flavours, further emphasising the deep connections between food and culture in India. Each bite was a burst of flavour, a reflection of the region's abundant natural resources and culinary traditions passed down through many generations.

I've also taken to social media to share these experiences and I've been overwhelmed by the enthusiastic responses and suggestions from people across India. From cashew macaroons in Tirunelveli (Tamil Nadu) to banana chips in Kerala, each recommendation has been a new chapter in my ongoing culinary adventure.

Food, in many ways, is a bridge that connects us all and through these shared experiences, I've felt a deeper connection with the people of India.

STRENGTHENING BILATERAL TIES

While my travels and culinary experiences have enriched my personal journey, the professional milestones we've achieved together are a testament to the strength of the US-India relationship. Last fall, I had the honour of handing over the one-millionth non-immigrant visa issued by the US Mission to India that year. This achievement is not just a number; it symbolises the growing ties between our nations and the increased desire for Indians

to explore opportunities in the United States—whether for education, business or tourism.

Last year, our mission issued more than 1,40,000 student visas; one out of every four foreign students in the United States is from India, with a total of nearly 3,00,000 Indians studying at US colleges and universities. Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President Joe Biden set an ambitious goal to improve and expedite the visa process and I'm proud to say that we have delivered on that promise. The consular teams at the embassy and four consulates work tirelessly to ensure that we meet the surging demand. We hope that you will soon visit us in the United States, including my home town of Los Angeles, thanks to the increasing direct flight connections between our countries.

Today, the United States is India's largest trading partner, with nearly US\$200 billion in two-way trade. And that includes planes like the one you might be sitting in! Indian-origin CEOs head many of the United States' largest and most iconic companies, like Alphabet/ Google, Microsoft, Starbucks, and Adobe, and the diaspora continues to grow. My goal as the Ambassador is to build on and expand these personal ties between our peoples, in both directions.

From the signing of the Cultural Property Agreement, which will help protect India's rich heritage, to our collaborations in





space exploration, the US-India relationship is stronger than ever. Our efforts centred on the US-India Initiative on Critical and Emerging Technologies (iCET) are not just about strengthening ties between governments but also about building lasting relationships between our research institutes and our people.

My time in India has been a journey of discovery, both personally and professionally. Every sunrise I witness, every dish I taste, and every milestone we achieve together, deepens my admiration for this incredible country.



TO SPEAKEASI

From old world architecture to modernist aesthetics, Chicago's skyline is iconic, as are its Prohibition-era speakeasies, food halls, and Michelinstar restaurants

f you're on a business trip to the Windy City, with limited time, don't miss the iconic skyscrapers. Their breathtaking architecture is a testament to Chicago's proud design heritage. Never before have I stared at a staircase so long—smitten by its geometry and besotted by the repeating patterns of the balustrades. I'm talking about an oriel staircase winding down daintily from the 12^{th} to the 2nd floor of the Rookery Building, one of the oldest standing skyscrapers

in Chicago, Illinois. The
Light Court, a two-storeyed
space of wrought iron and
glass, designed by Frank
Lloyd Wright, is yet another
marvel. I could spend hours
swathed in the Court's
natural light but I had
more skyscraper-gaping to
do—Aqua Tower with its
rippling facade; the iconic
Willis Tower; The St. Regis
Chicago, a 101-storey
building designed by a

renowned female architect,
Jeanne Gang; and the
Tribune Tower that bears
chips from historic sites
around the world. Chicago's
skyscrapers are innumerable.
So, I whooshed up to the
94th floor Observation
Deck of the 875 North
Michigan Avenue (erstwhile
John Hancock Center)
for a 360-degree view of
the skyline. Whether for
business or leisure, admiring

stunning architecture is always a favourite.

After a long walk and admiring the cityscape, your stomach will surely be ready for a bite. I mused whether to wave the fork in a Michelin-star restaurant or quaff inside a speakeasy. And speakeasy, it was. I took

a swig at The Violet Hour, rooted in pre-Prohibition style libations, and another in Three Dots and a Dash, a tiki bar where drinks are served in quaint custom vessels. Dinner at Michelinstarred Bavette's Bar & Boeuf was the perfect epilogue to the day.

As dusk transitioned into an inky night and the skyscrapers wore their glitters, an unseen bluesman sang. I strolled by the Chicago river and recalled Mr Wright's prophecy: "Eventually, I think Chicago will be the most beautiful great city left in the world."

BEST TIME TO VISIT

Temperatures are pleasant around **April, May**, and between **September** and **October**. Summer is peak tourist season with plenty of festivals and outdoor activities for visitors to enjoy.





THE DUAL PULSE

Hollywood's glamour or Silicon Beach's creativity—there's always something to love in Los Angeles

iving in LA feels like being at the heart of a vibrant, ever-evolving city. Not only is it the home of Hollywood's glitz and glamour but it's also a bustling tech hub where established and emerging entrepreneurs thrive. I'm constantly inspired by the iconic landmarks, cutting-edge venues, unique museums, and hidden gems that surround me. In the City of Angels, collaborative spaces and creative energy make every day an adventure. Begin this adventure with a walking tour of Hollywood Boulevard. During this, you will visit the Hollywood Walk of Fame, The Hollywood Roosevelt, Amoeba Music, and the historic TCL Chinese Theatre, where you are likely

to catch a red-carpet event. Undoubtedly, Los Angeles boasts a diverse culinary landscape. Some of the finest celebrity hotspots, apt for both client meetings and catching up with friends, are Nobu Malibu, Polo Lounge, The Tower Bar, Amour Weho, and Providence. For a taste of Californian cuisine, check out Coucou in West Hollywood, an indoor-outdoor restaurant serving a delightful 'Parisianmeets-Pacific' fare. In the evening, go for a show at the Hollywood Bowl, an outdoor amphitheatre that hosts musical performances in an awe-inspiring setting.

Further, LA is home to a

few of the most spectacular beaches in the world—from the vibrant boardwalk of Venice Beach to the tranquil coves of Malibu. To people's surprise, the city also boasts a thriving art scene with the Academy Museum of Motion Pictures, The Broad, Getty Center, and the Los Angeles County Museum of Art. The Jeffrey Deitch gallery elevates a bright warehouse space through museum-like presentation.

LA's sports stadiums are world-class, to say the least. The recently-opened Intuit Dome is a sports arena featuring an avantgarde design, futuristic technology, and unparalleled fan experiences. It is home to artworks by celebrated artists, including an arresting mural by Shepard Fairey.

When in LA, I always recommend checking the event line-up at the Los Angeles Convention Center, a multipurpose venue that hosts a wide range of events. For digital nomads, the city's coworking spaces, including NeueHouse Hollywood, Rita House, and Phase Two, are worth exploring.

Whether I'm chasing glamour or seeking the perfect nook for my business meetings, Los Angeles never fails to amaze.








BITING THE BIG APPLE

BEST TIME TO

New York is great any time of year but autumn is specialit's not so crowded, prices are great, and fall colours can be seen everywhere.

f there is one city in the world I can never tire of, it's New York. There's always something 'new' here. So, whenever I'm in my favourite city, I make it a point to check out the latest attractions, explore neighbourhoods I haven't been to before, and, of course, catch a show or two on Broadway.

My first rendezvous was with the Rock. Not the actor but Rockefeller Center, as it's fondly referred to by New Yorkers. The 360-degree views of the city from the Top of the Rock are legendary, after all. I had signed up for the VIP Tour, which lets you skip the long queues and comes with pretour drinks in the VIP lounge, use of a private elevator, and access to special areas, including the famed Rainbow Room.

What I was really keen on, though, was 'The Beam', their hottest new attraction. We've all seen that legendary image of construction workers having a meal on a beam, taken during the erection of the Center in 1932. You can now recreate that moment, weather permitting, on a custom-built beam on the

















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








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
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69th floor, which lifts you 12ft above the observation deck, then rotates 180-degrees, providing spectacular views of Central Park and beyond.

Photo-op done, it was time for a bus tour. The guide had us in splits with a disparaging sense of humour that's so typically New York as THE RIDE (a custom-built theatre bus) took us across the sights of Midtown and Times Square. At designated points, the bus would stop and street performers would enact a scene for us. For THE RIDE, the streets of NYC are the stage and the city's landmarks, the set.

Quite apt, as my next stop was Broadway. This is where the foot-tapping,

high-octane energy of New York reaches its peak. And I couldn't have chosen better than MJ The Musical. The queue ran right round the block but the wait was worth it, as the riveting story of the world's greatest pop artist unfolded before me. The 'moonwalk' was a bonus.

You can't come to New York City and not take in one of its great museums. While The Metropolitan Museum of Art (The Met) remained a favourite, the Museum Hack's private tour, which they tailor to your tastes, was perfect. The guide was smart, sassy, and sarcastic, and even threw in a glass of wine for good measure. If you find museums boring,

this tour will change your mind forever.

When we think of New York, more often than not, we're thinking only of Manhattan. But the city has four more boroughs with plenty to explore.

This time, I walked across the historic Brooklyn Bridge, took a left and found myself in DUMBO, an acronym for Down Under the Manhattan Bridge Overpass. This is also where you can take that iconic image of the Empire State Building framed by the Manhattan Bridge.

That's the thing about New York City—whether you look at it from above or below, it always manages to take your breath away.

From becoming an YouTube icon and advocating a better future for the world to penning her debut novel-Prajakta Koli has done it all. And she is nowhere close to stopping •

GROWING UP, YOU WANTED TO BECOME A RADIO JOCKEY. WHY DID YOU DECIDE TO CHANGE CAREERS?

Everything began with the realisation that I wasn't particularly good at radio. I wasn't enjoying it. An acquaintance suggested that I try making content on YouTube. It wasn't so much a planned decision as it was a way out of something that wasn't fulfilling. I took a leap of faith and the rest is history.

YOU WERE ALSO NAMED UNDP **INDIA'S FIRST YOUTH CLIMATE CHAMPION. HOW DID THAT COME ABOUT?**

It all started in 2016 when I began conversations around body positivity, which gradually expanded into education, gender equality, and inclusivity. Climate action naturally

became one of these dominoes. I've been fortunate to partner with incredible organisations and people, including the Obama Foundation, Gates Foundation, and YouTube, which has been a significant platform and power tool for me. This ongoing engagement led to UNDP reaching out to me, which is how I became their Youth Climate Champion from India.

YOU ALSO COVERED THE WORLD ECONOMIC FORUM'S ANNUAL MEETING AT DAVOS LAST YEAR. HOW HAS THAT **EXPERIENCE BEEN?**

It was my first time there and it was amazing to see so many influential people gathered in one place. Those rooms were probably the only times where I have felt that both parts of the problem and parts of the

solution were present together, working on the issues at hand. It was a fantastic learning experience.

WHAT ARE THE CAUSES THAT **RESONATE WITH YOU MOST?**

Fitness has become a significant part of my life, both for my mental and physical well-being. That's why the partnership with the 2024 Olympics, particularly through their 'Let's Move' campaign, was so meaningful. It aims to inspire young adults to embrace the benefits of movement and sports, which aligns perfectly with my own beliefs.

Climate action is equally crucial. As someone who has been actively advocating for sustainable living and environmental awareness, I believe it's imperative that we highlight the urgency of addressing climate change. This isn't just about policy; it's about making individual choices that collectively make a big impact.

Education is another pillar that I am passionate about. Gender equality ties into this as well because education is a fundamental right that should be available to all, regardless of gender.

YOUR DEBUT BOOK IS SET FOR RELEASE LATER THIS YEAR, TOO.

Becoming an author is a completely new experience. I'm excited but also anxious to see how it's received.

A LESSON THAT HAS SERVED YOU IN GOOD STEAD ALL THESE YEARS?

Being my biggest cheerleader. I'm my own best-friend and my biggest fan. I work hard: I love what I do and I'm proud of it. I've been fortunate to have an amazing audience and community both online and offline. Reminding myself of this keeps me grounded and motivated all the time.

BELONGING TO THE GENERATION THAT IS PAVING NEW PATHS FOR OUR COUNTRY, WHAT ARE YOUR THOUGHTS ON 'NEW INDIA'?





DIVIDEND

As one of the highest dividend-paying companies among its peers, the Board has recommended a final dividend of ₹5 per equity share, subject to your approval for the financial year 2023-24.

The total dividend for the financial year, including the proposed final dividend, amounts to ₹16 per share i.e. 160% of the paid-up share capital, compared to ₹12.60 per share i.e. 126% of the paid-up share capital, for the previous year. The total dividend payout for the financial year 2023-24, including the proposed final dividend, will be ₹4,213.16 crore.



IN WHAT WAYS DOES YOUR LATEST COUTURE COLLECTION STUDIO MIX TRY TO CAPTURE THE ALLURE OF THE SWINGING 70S?

PALATE ECHOES

Food's universal language connects two distant countries—India and Mexico—revealing a surprising closeness in culture



Rice is a key ingredient in both India and Mexico, featuring extensively in their cuisines. Rice *kheer* and *arroz con leche* share a common lineage of creamy, indulgent desserts that celebrate rice. *Kheer*, a rich traditional rice-based Indian dessert, is spiced with cardamom and saffron, and garnished with dried fruits and nuts. *Arroz con leche*, a Mexican favourite, uses cinnamon and raisins to create a deliciously-spiced, creamy rice pudding.

INGREDIENTS TO HIGHLIGHT:

India-Short grain rice like gobindobhog or sona masoori

Mexico-Medium grain rice like arroz de grano medio



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Sliced, juicy tropical fruits meet the tangy, spicy savouriness of a chilli-salt-lime mix. In India, summer means street stalls piled high with fleshy guavas and mangoes, topped with a heavy sprinkle of salt, hot chilli powder, and a squeeze of lime. Mexico's tropical climes offer mangoes, melons, and jicama, all seasoned with Tajin, a popular spice-salt mix. This blend contains dried lime powder, adding a zingy tang.

INGREDIENTS TO HIGHLIGHT:

India-Kashmiri chilli powder, black salt

Mexico-Tajín, a blend of dried Mexican peppers like guajillo, pasilla or ancho, lime, salt to taste





O OKHAL O MOLCAJETE

You can opt for old or nouveau methods but some kitchen tools remain unchanged. One such essential traditional tool is the mortar and pestle, in various sizes. The Indian okhal is ideal for grinding spices into fragrant pastes and masalas. The molcajete, a Mexican version, crushes tomatillos and chilli peppers into chunky salsas, or coarsely mashes avocados for guacamole. Both offer textures that electric blenders can't replicate.

HISTORICAL CONNECTION: Both ancient kitchen tools are used for artisanal food preparation even today

○ CHUTNEYS SALSA

A combination of herbs, spices, fruits, and nuts—chutneys and salsas add vibrant colours and essential flavours. In India, over 30 traditional varieties, including coriander, coconut, tomato, and mango, are commonly prepared, rendering many street foods and sides incomplete without them. In Mexico, salsa rules, with about 20 regional variations—from the cooked salsa roja, made with tomato and chillies, to the refreshing salsa verde, featuring tomatillos, green chillies, and cilantro.

INGREDIENTS TO HIGHLIGHT:

India-Coriander, coconut, tamarind **Mexico-**Tomato, cilantro, chipotle



















Bread is a cornerstone of any cuisine, and among the many varieties, the *roomali* roti in India and the Sonoran tortilla from the Sonora region in northern Mexico, stand out. *Roomali*, meaning 'handkerchief' in Urdu, is an incredibly thin, white flour flatbread cooked on an inverted griddle. It pairs exquisitely with curries and kebabs. Sonoran tortilla is a thin, chewy, hearty, white flour bread—a newer addition to Mexican cuisine—often used for burritos or griddle-fried quesadillas.

INGREDIENTS TO HIGHLIGHT:

India-White flour, ghee **Mexico-**White flour, lard, baking powder

○ CURRY **◇** MOLE

Complex sauces form an essential part of many traditional dishes. Curry, a blend of spices, has links to ancient spice trade routes that influenced regional Indian cooking styles through elaborate vegetable and meat preparations. *Mole* is a quintessential Mexican sauce that traces its history to pre-Columbian Mesoamerican cultures that combine native ingredients with Spanish influences, including chillies and chocolate, with a smattering of nuts. They both reflect an intricate heritage for comfort fares.

INGREDIENTS TO HIGHLIGHT:

India-Kashmiri chillies, dry spices, tomatoes
Mexico-Abuelita/Ibarra (Mexican cooking chocolate brands),
almonds, pasilla chillies







10 BLUE POTTERY OF JAIPUR

A trip to the state capital is not complete if you don't splurge on its eponymous handmade bluehued ceramic craft. And those looking for an immersive experience, there are a few outlets across the city—on Amber Road, Gopalpura Bypass, and Tonk Road—that conduct workshops. You can make a plate or design a colourful tile under expert guidance. If you are apprehensive that the fragile objects may break during transit, some shops will gladly courier them to your address.



9 PUPPETS AND MINIATURE PAINTINGS

GI tagged, the Kathputlis of Rajasthan are the most identifiable aspect of the state's cultural fabric. Catch vibrant puppet shows at Amer Fort, Jaipur; Bagore Ki Haveli Museum, Udaipur; and Desert Culture Centre and Museum, Jaisalmer (master puppeteers offer workshops here). Equally colourful are the miniature paintings marked by different styles, with Mewar and Bundi being the most popular ones. The Chitrashala in Taragarh Fort, Bundi, is one of the best spots to witness this art form. Catch miniature artists at work at Bundi's local markets.





○ ○ SHEKHAWATI

For the artistically inclined, a trip to the historical Shekhawati region is a must. Also known as an open art gallery, it is dotted with grand palaces like Goenka, Jhunjhunwala, Char Chowk Ki Haveli, and Chaudhari Haveli that are decorated with delicate yet ornate frescoes. These intricate artworks have been painstakingly restored by the palace owners across Shekhawati using natural colours and traditional materials that include chuna-surkhi (lime and trass). It is an ongoing process where local artisans learn from expert painters. Many havelis even welcome visitors and offer guided tours of their stunning wall murals.




MEENAKARI AND JADAU JEWELLERY

As intricate as they are beautiful, meenakari and jadau jewellery are Rajasthan's pride and speak volumes of its rich cultural heritage. While the first involves setting precious stones into gold and enamelling them, in the latter, such precious stones as emeralds, rubies, and diamonds are embedded into softened gold. Visit the jewellers that line the streets of Johari Bazar, Jaipur, to witness the craftsmen at work. Rajasthan is also known for its traditional yet oppulent kundan, polki, and thewa jewelleries must-haves in your collection for their time-honoured elegance.

U LEHRIYA AND BANDHANI TEXTILES

Nothing, perhaps, embodies the vibrant ethos of Rajasthan more than its textiles, with the bandhani and the lehriya reigning supreme. These two techniques are used in a wide range of clothing—from sarees and dupattas (or odhnis for the locals) to turbans and traditional poshak. To get a hands-on experience, visit tie-dye guru Ishwar Dewani's workshop in Jodhpur's Clock Tower market. The lehriya stripes vary in thickness and can be multi-hued, like the five-coloured panchranga and seven-coloured satranga. Master craftsman Dr Badshah Miyan conducts tours in the process of lehriya in Jaipur.





If you are in Rajasthan this September, don't miss Jodhpur RIFF, an annual international roots (folk) music festival between 16th and 20th October 2024.

O SAMBHAR SALT LAKE

Take a calming break at the pinkhued Sambhar Lake, nestled in the historic town of the same name. This tourist hotspot is a Ramsar Site and India's largest saline wetland. From remnants of colonial-era heritage buildings and a salt museum to a trolley train—it's an ideal getaway as well as an Instagrammable spot. Perhaps the most appealing element here is the migration of thousands of flamingos and other birds from northern Asia and Siberia (Nov-Feb) making it a birdwatcher's paradise. Enhance your travel experience here with off-roading activities, bird-watching camps, and heritage walks.







he aroma of spices, Arabic coffee, and incense hangs thick in the air as I stroll through Souq Waqif, Doha's bustling, century-old marketplace. Entering it on my first day in the city, I realise there is no better way to experience the Qatari capital than through its vibrant souks, where tradition, culture, and shopping converge seamlessly in one colourful melting pot.

At the heart of this experience is Souq Waqif, or 'the standing souk', where the alleyways amid the muddaubed buildings are lined with shops selling handcrafted perfumes, intricate handicrafts, pearls, and traditional garments. There is a variety of restaurants offering authentic Qatari cuisine and, as night falls, one can even unwind at any of the shisha (hookah) bars in the market.

Built on the site of Doha's centuryold trading market on the banks of the Wadi Musheireb, the souk makes me realise how tradition is built into the very DNA of this city, making it a heady mix of the old and new. As I wander through the main promenade, I spot local vendors selling Arabic coffee,



karak tea, and delicious local snacks like ragag or thin crêpes with toppings like cheese, honey, and more.

It's easy to lose sense of time in the shops that entice everyone (locals and tourists alike) with their wide range of offerings—from expensive pearls and antiques to reasonably-priced souvenirs that make great gifts. I step into an incense shop and find myself immersed in the bouget of fragrances for longer than I intended.

Going ahead, I am mesmerised by a massive bronze thumb sculpture with a gold patina. My tour guide tells me that it is called Le Pouce and was created by French artist César Baldaccini to commemorate the moment Qatar won the Asian Cup in February 2019.

Get ready for a delightful array of flavours and explore Doha's rich food culture with Qatari cuisine that blends influences from India, Persia, Lebanon, and North Africa. Lunch is at Damasca One, a Syrian restaurant with intricate wooden carvings, mosaic tiles, and ornate chandeliers. The meal is a feast of Middle Eastern flavours with a mezze platter, kebabs, kibbeh, majboos (very similar to biryani) and a dish called warak enab (vine leaves stuffed with meat and rice).

Each souk unravels a different story about Qatar's heritage. In Falcon Souq, a buzzing marketplace in the

heart of this capital city, one can take a deep dive into falconry by watching these majestic birds, listening to their stories, and understanding why they are such an important part of Qatar's culture. Developed by the Bedouin tribes, the art of training falcons to hunt for food goes back centuries. One can even feed Qatar's national bird here or, as I chose to do, just pose with one perched on their arm. That's not all. Nearby, a camel pen offers a chance to see the mighty ships of the desert up close and personal.

'All that glitters is not gold' is a phrase that cannot be applied in Doha. In fact, if anything, the opposite is true here—especially at the Gold Souq, a glittering hotspot. From traditional Arabian designs to modern, contemporary pieces, the dazzling shops offer exquisite gold jewellery and, browsing around, it is quite easy to get tempted by ornaments that gleam, glitter, and call out to you.


Art enthusiasts as well as curious tourists cannot ignore the Souq Waqif Art Centre that is stocked with paintings—available for sale—by local and visiting artists. This centre, decorated with beautiful woodwork, hand-painted tiles, and colourful lanterns, is all about showcasing

diverse forms of visual arts that reflect the heritage and tradition of the State of Qatar. It hosts exhibitions throughout the year and conducts workshops on sculpting, pottery, Arabic calligraphy, and more.

Souq Al Dira is yet another colourful haven for gorgeous textiles that go all the way from shimmering organza to luxurious silks and from soft cottons, crepes, and georgettes, to cashmere pashminas. You're sure to be spoilt for choice. And if time permits, you can even have your purchases tailored. Prices are not fixed, so don't think

twice before deciding to bargain. It's a lively and colourful market—perfect for someone who's looking for fabrics.

As I wrap up my exploration of the perfumed alleyways to discover spices, trinkets, and treasures, I soon realise that Doha's souks are more than places to shop—they are living, breathing parts of a city that blend tradition with contemporary flair. Each market narrates tales of ancient heritage.

What I will always remember fondly is the warmth of the locals who keep the charm of these souks alive, finding a place in our hearts and memories.


